We will be

- continuing to develop our pencil control

- continuing to handle different tools such as: scissors, play dough tools, tweezers

 enjoying a range of activities that move our bodies, such as yoga and long walks

Communication and Language

We will be

- beginning to ask questions, questioning why things happen and how
- beginning to give our own explanations in response to questions
- building vocabulary based on our topic and experiences

Literacy

We will be

- continuing to form letters correctly

- writing for different purposes, including role play

- applying phonic knowledge to attempt writing words and simple sentences

- learning 'digraph' sounds, words and revising ones previously taught

- looking at non-fiction books and stories linked to our topic

We will be

- talking about all living things are precious to God

- thinking about how Christians believed the world began

RE

- thinking about who cares for our special world and why



Mathematics

We will be

- introducing early addition skills by finding the total number of items in two groups

- finding one more or one less than a given number

- encouraging the children to use mathematical language within all contexts, in particular positional language such as over, under and through

Understanding the World

We will be

- talking about different countries and continents, who and what it's like to live there, making comparisons with our local area

- using the computers and iPads as part of our learning

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be

- looking at different artists and art from around the world, experimenting with similar styles

- using a variety of materials to create models

 learning a variety of songs from different countries and exploring instruments

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be

- listening to others ideas and learning to take them into account

- explaining our own knowledge and understanding, and asking appropriate questions of others
- learning to speak confidently and to speak to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions
- aware of the boundaries set, and of behavioural expectations
