Year One

Computing:

Y1 will be learning to use the Chromebooks, investigating computer systems and networks and programming.

Music:

We will be learning about classical music, dynamics, tempo and rhythmic patterns through the topics of Animals and Fairytales.

Science:

Y1 will be learning about seasonal changes. This will include looking at the growth and development of animals and plants and changes in the weather.

Wellbeing

We will continue with our weekly wellbeing tasks and PHSE lessons about coping with different emotions using the zones of regulation.

We will also learn about how to keep safe and how to take care of living things.

Geography:

The children will be learning about the United Kingdom, the city of London and its famous landmarks.

They will name and describe the purpose of human features and landmarks.

Literacy:

Children will be creating their own information posters about London. They will be writing lists, labels and captions. Children will develop their topic vocabulary and learn how to present information concisely. Children will also be learning how to write a set of directions from one landmark to another.

Y1 will be focussing on building language, vocabulary and grammar. We will continue to work on practising correct letter and number formation.

Phonics and reading:

It is vital for your child to be reading **every day**. The reading planet colour banded books will reinforce children's learning and knowledge of phonics.

Please ensure that their books are in their bags **every day**.

Art and Design Technology:

We will be creating our own motifs and we will be exploring line, shape, texture. We will also be creating 2D models, using different techniques to join and attach materials.
