 appearances to bring some cheer around the school!
- In the past, we've purchased new reading books, iPads, a wifi upgrade and a drumming workshop.
- We're currently working with Mrs Mitchell and Mrs Lee looking into funding improvements for the outdoor
 areas and supporting new technology in the classrooms.
