If your child has a high temperature, a new continuous cough, or a loss of taste or smell, please do not send your child into school, but contact your doctor for advice.

Punctuality

There are quite a few children arriving late to school. Please note that although the timings of the school day have changed, the rules regarding registration remain the same. Any child arriving more than 5 minutes late will receive a late mark, and this will be monitored by our Educational Welfare Officer.
