Intent

Coulsdon CofE Primary will endeavour to continue to provide a holistic, creative, broad and balanced curriculum from the 5th January 2021 using a variety of approaches via Google classroom.

- Live interactive lessons each morning
- Maintaining a cross curricular approach where appropriate
- Additional live lessons of music and Spanish in KS2 and phonics in KS1
- A range of tasks/activities set on Google Classroom incorporating all curriculum areas:

Literacy	Maths
PE	Music
Art	Design and Technology
Cooking	Geography
History	ICT
Science	PHSE
- As a Church of England Primary school we will continue to provide Religious Education lessons following the Southwark Diocese scheme of work while also continuing to focus on children's moral, social and spiritual development.
- All children will have the opportunity to access the same curriculum offer at home and at school.

Implementation

A wide range of approaches will be used by teachers and TAs to support and develop children's learning e.g.

Each week will include:

- A Creative Monday morning activity
- Wellbeing Wednesday focus
- A recorded collective worship for the whole school community delivered by Paul our Rector.
- Daily Croydon Sports partnership PE activities for KS2
- Mindfulness

Resources to enhance the development of skills and progression in children:

- White Rose Maths
- My Maths
- Cornerstones creative themes
- Reading Planet
- Rock star maths
- Farr phonics / read, write, inc
- Read, write inc

Not all tasks need to be completed on electronic devices so that children continue to improve their fine and gross motor coordination skills that were lost during the last lockdown.

Key Stage 1 and EYFS	A minimum of 3 hours Live lessons in the morning at 9:15 and 11:00 am via google classroom. Assignments set via google classroom.
Key Stage 2	A minimum of 4 hours Live lessons in the morning at 9:15 and 11:00 am via google classroom. Assignments set via google classroom.

Additional support for SEND children

Small group differentiated remote teaching will be provided whenever possible for live lessons. All children with EHCP's are in school with 1:1 support.

Class teacher / SENCO to phone families regularly.

Communication with parents

Accessing remote education

All children have access to google classroom and time was spent during the Autumn term 2020 ensuring that all pupils' and parents were confident at using this platform.

We recognise that some children may not have suitable online access at home. Where a child does not have access to the internet or an appropriate devices at home staff will be in contact to discuss the support available for:

- An electronic device/chromebook (we have also received additional devices from St John's Church and eight devices from the Government which can be distributed to vulnerable families)
- Provision of internet access at home
- Paper based learning if required

Engagement

- We expect children to attend the Google Meet each day
- We expect children to complete the work set and submit it to their teachers
- Engagement will be checked daily
- We will email/ring parents of children not engaging in their learning to discuss and offer support
- We will work with any parents struggling to access online resources to look at ways in which this can be resolved

Feedback, Assessment of children's work and progress

Feedback can take many forms and may not always mean extensive written comments for individual children e.g:

- Children receive daily feedback on their work via Google Classroom or Meets both collectively and or individually. This may be verbally or written.
- Quizzes marked automatically
- Children may also receive feedback through Google Meets
- 1:1 conferencing will continue to be offered, particularly for writing.

Remote education for children who are self-isolating

All learning that is taking place in class and at home will be placed on Google Classroom daily. Children will be able to access this learning from home when in isolation and attend the live sessions.
