Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a number of complaints from residents regarding drop off and pick up times. Residents are stating that members of our school community are blocking their driveways in order to drop their children off. This is preventing them from leaving their properties at these times.

Please can I remind you of rule 243 in the Highway Code. It advises drivers:

DO NOT stop or park:

- near a school entrance
- anywhere you would prevent access for Emergency Services
- where the kerb has been lowered to help wheelchair users and powered mobility vehicles
- *in front of an entrance to a property*
