Firstly, may we say how well behaved the whole class were when we went to Keston School for our rehearsal on Tuesday; they represented our school beautifully, and we were very proud of them. Thank you to those parents who gave up their time to accompany us. Without parental support, these trips cannot go ahead.

This letter contains vital information regarding the sale of tickets for the Infant Music Festival at Fairfield Halls, as well as details of our Fairfield Halls rehearsal.

REHEARSALS

On Tuesday 10th March, Year 2 will be going to the Fairfield Halls for a rehearsal. It will be the first opportunity for the children to sing as one big choir with all the other participating schools, at the venue where the concert will take place.

The rehearsal will take place during the afternoon, finishing at approximately 2:45pm. We will be travelling by bus to Croydon after lunch, and returning back to school by bus after the rehearsal. This means that the school day will finish later than usual. We will keep the office notified of our ETA, but anticipate that we will be back at school around 3:45pm.

There will be a second rehearsal at Fairfield Halls on the morning of the concert, Wednesday 18th March. This takes place from 10am-12noon. Again, we will travel by bus, returning to school for a slightly later than usual lunch.

We will need parent helpers for both of these trips, so please let the office know if you are able to join us. If we do not have enough adults to accompany the children, we will be unable to go.

TICKETS

We have been informed that the tickets for the concert go on sale early next week. These go on general sale to the public, so please ensure that you are prompt in purchasing tickets.

Tickets can only be purchased through the Fairfield Halls box office. Prices listed below are correct for last year. These prices are subject to review, but give you an idea of what the cost is. This is outside of our control; all queries regarding ticketing should therefore be directed to the Fairfield Halls.
