Dear Parents & Carers,

I am thrilled to announce that we have booked our place for Young Voices 2027, at the O2 Arena! Our concert date is Wednesday 3rd February. This year, the children were a part of an 8,287 strong choir in one of the world's most iconic concert venues!

We have a limited number of spaces available, and the choir is open to all children who will be in years 4, 5 and 6 in September, on a first come first served basis. Rehearsals will take place on Wednesdays after school from **3:20pm-4:30pm**. Please note the finish time is different to most other clubs. If your child would like to participate, but cannot make it on Wednesdays, please come and talk to me

I will be holding a meeting on Wednesday 15th July straight after school in the Year 4 classroom to share more about Young Voices. This meeting is not obligatory, but purely for information purposes (I can send out any info to those who would like it, but who are unable to attend).

There will be costs for audience tickets and optional YV t-shirts; last year's prices were £27 and £15 respectively, as well as coach hire to the venue (TBC). Last year's coach cost approximately £470. This cost is apportioned evenly once we know how many children want to take part. We will be asking for a non-refundable deposit payable by the end of September. Failure to do so will result in your child's place being given to somebody else and they will no longer be allowed to take part. Payment is also required for participation in the school-run club. As with any costed event, please speak to the office if you require financial support.

Parents will be responsible for getting the children home from the London O2 after the event.
