REHEARSALS

Next Tuesday, 10th March, Year 2 will be going to the Fairfield Halls for a rehearsal. It will be the first opportunity for the children to sing as one big choir with all the other participating schools, at the venue where the concert will take place.

The rehearsal will take place during the afternoon, finishing at approximately 2:45pm. We will be travelling by bus to Croydon after lunch, and returning back to school by bus after the rehearsal. This means that the school day will finish later than usual. We will keep the office notified of our ETA, but anticipate that we will be back at school around 3:45pm.

There will be a second rehearsal at Fairfield Halls on the morning of the concert, Wednesday 18th March. This takes place from 10am-12pm and again, we will travel by bus, returning to school for a slightly later than usual lunch.

We still need parent helpers for the 10th March, so please let us know if you are able to join us. If we do not have enough adults to accompany the children, we will be unable to go.
