Year 3 & 4 Trip to Southwark Cathedral

On Wednesday 23rd April, Years 3 and 4 will be visiting Southwark Cathedral to take part in a candle-making workshop and an interactive tour of the cathedral, exploring Christian signs and symbols.

We will be travelling to and from London using public transport, taking the train from Coulsdon South Station to London Bridge, then taking a short walk from there.

We will be leaving school after morning registration and are expecting to arrive back at Coulsdon South Station at 3.25pm. Please arrange to collect your child from the Reddown Road exit of Coulsdon South Station at this time. This is obviously dependent on trains running on time, and we will notify you by text if the children will be delayed. If you have younger siblings at the school, please collect them first before going to the station. We will keep the children safely with us until you arrive. If your child will be attending the after-school wraparound care club, we will walk them back to school with us.

We will be taking packed lunches with us which will have been prepared by the school caterers, and the children will order their fillings in advance. Children should wear full, smart school uniform and bring a waterproof coat. They will also need a small, named rucksack-type bag to carry their water bottle and packed lunch.

The cost of this trip is £8.10 and this should be made on ParentPay in the usual way.
