### Year 4 Trip to the Science Museum

On Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April, Year 4 will be visiting the Science Museum so that the children can gain real-life experiences of science and discover some of the most iconic items that have shaped our society! This ties in well with our next topic on 'Electricity' and how electrical appliances have changed over the years. The children will also have the opportunity to participate in interactive exhibitions, including a newly commissioned musical playground!

We will be travelling to and from London using public transport, taking the train from Coulston South Station to Blackfriars, then changing to take the tube to South Kensington. The museum is a short walk from there.

We will be leaving school after morning registration and are expecting to arrive back at Coulston South Station at 3.25pm. Please arrange to collect your child from the Reddown Road exit of Coulston South Station at this time. This is obviously dependent on trains running on time, and we will notify you by text if the children will be delayed. If you have younger siblings at the school, please collect them first before going to the station. I will keep the children safely with me until you arrive. We will be taking packed lunches with us which will have been prepared by the school caterers, and the children will order their fillings in advance. Children should wear full, smart school uniform and bring a waterproof coat. They will also need a small, named rucksack-type bag to carry their water bottle and packed lunch.

We are very grateful to the Friends Committee who have allocated an amount of money to each class for school trips and activities. The majority of the cost will be covered by this, and we are asking parents to pay the reduced amount of £1 for each child to cover the cost of the "Turn it Up" exhibition, and this should be made on ParentPay in the usual way.
