## $\frac{\text{Re Year 6 School Journey to PGL Centre, Little Canada, Wootton Bridge, Isle of Wight}{16^{\text{th}} - 20^{\text{th}} \text{ October 2023}}$

We are pleased to tell you that we have booked a residential school journey to the PGL Centre at Little Canada, Wootton Bridge, Isle of Wight from Monday 16<sup>th</sup> to Friday 20<sup>th</sup> October 2023. This is an excellent opportunity for the children to have a different educational experience at the beginning of Year 6, and to learn personal skills including team building, resilience and increased independence.

The children will be able to experience a wide range of activities every day and evening at the centre which may include: archery, challenge courses, sports and team games, quiz evening and a disco evening. All activities are supervised and led by the qualified PGL team leaders. Accommodation is in dormitories with ensuite bathrooms. The Year 6 teacher will be leading the week accompanied by several other members of staff.

The cost for the week will be £366, and this takes into account a saving of £18 per child following negotiations with PGL. The coach will complete the return journey from school to the Isle of Wight, including the ferry crossing. The Governors, as in previous years, will contribute £800 towards the cost of the coach.

We will need a non-refundable deposit of £70 to secure your child's place by 24<sup>th</sup> February. The remaining payment of £296 should be made in instalments via ParentPay during the months leading up to the trip – please see the payment schedule attached. Alternatively, you can make larger instalments or pay in full earlier if you wish. **All payments must be made in full by Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2023**. If any parent has any problems at all with payment, please come and see Mrs Hancox as soon as possible to discuss this. We would be grateful if you would also complete the Google form to give permission for your child to take part in the trip.

These adventure weeks are an excellent opportunity for your children to become more independent and confident in the lead up to starting secondary school in 2024, as well as being a lot of fun!
