Year 6 Trip to The National Army Museum – 15th November 2022

As part of our topic work on World War II this term, I have planned a trip for year 6 to visit the National Army Museum in London, where we will be taking part in a workshop about The Blitz and visiting the galleries and exhibitions in the museum.

The travel arrangements for the day will be:

- Depart from school at 9am
- Walk or take the bus to Coulsdon South Station & take the train to London Victoria
- Take the tube from London Victoria to Sloane Square
- Short walk to the Museum
- Return travel as above and arrive back at the Reddown Road exit of Coulsdon South Station at approximately 4.30pm. Please make arrangements for your child to be collected from there. If for any reason this time changes, you will be notified by text message

The children will need to wear their school uniform and bring a warm waterproof jacket. Harrison Catering will provide packed lunches for the children at the usual lunch cost of £2.55, and we would be grateful if you would ensure that there is sufficient credit on your account on the day. The kitchen staff are aware of the dietary needs within the class, and these will be catered for. There is no further cost for this trip.
